Pursuant to the Show Cause Notice, the Customs department has called upon the Company that why the Company should not pay the duty as well as the interest and penalty on the goods imported under the Project Import Regulations in 2012 for Upper Bhadra lift irrigation scheme package - I implemented by Karnataka Neeravari Nigam Limited. The Show Cause Notice dated 24.09.2025 was received by the Company on 14th October, 2025.
II.	Expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty, etc. :	As the project is being extended from time to time and recently is it extended upto 31/03/2026, the Company is taking appropriate steps to file a reply against the Show Cause Notice received from the Customs Authorities. The Company has a strong case on merits and does not foresee any material impact on the financial, operational, or other activities.
iii.	Quantum of claims, if any:	Differential Custom duty demanded on total Assessable value of Rs. 34.58 crores cleared under the project import regulations along with applicable interest and penalty pursuant to the Show Cause Notice received from the Customs Authorities.
